Behind the Scenes

Royal Melbourne Show

Every year Warratina Lavender Farm attends the Royal Melbourne Show. It is one of Melbourne's and the Farm's biggest events of the year.

Many hours of preparations go into attending the Show ranging from stock list of products, props, signage, display furniture to be organised and packed. All of the gear is taken to the transport company with instructions of time and location of show and when delivery to show required (1 week before set-up). When the team arrives at the event they spend a full day setting up before the official opening. The show runs for a HUGE 12 days. The stand at the show helps Warratina not only gain valuable sales of products, but also provides a fantastic opportunity for the staff to meet people and tell them all about the wonderful benefits of lavender!

At the end of show all the left over products are repacked, loaded onto a pallet ready for pick up the next day to be returned to the transport depot. The goods are picked up, returned to farm, unpacked and count taken of goods sold. This list is then used as a guide for the next year's show. We would love to see you at this year's show so come and see us!
